**Abstract:** The purpose of the article is to present a codification of private international law in the Dominican Republic. The article describes the Civil Code of the Dominican Republic from 1845, amended in 1882, with an outline of its international private law regulations. The Dominican Republic has been participating in international conferences and organizations, e.g. the Sixth International Conference of American States in Havana (1928), Inter-American Specialized Conferences on Private International Law (CIDIP) of the Organization of American States (OAS), the Hague Conference on Private International Law (HCCH) and Organization for the Harmonization of Business Law in the Caribbean (OHADAC). This resulted in signing by the Dominican Republic of a number of the international conventions and treaties that are listed in the article. Then an overview of the Act on private international law of the Dominican Republic from 2014 is provided. The article includes an analysis of the general norms and particular provisions of the special part of the Act on private international law of the Dominican Republic e.g. natural persons, legal entities, choice of law, marriage, inheritance, and contains comparative remarks.
