Abstract:

Ministry of Justice is taking steps to introduce the admissibility of extrajudicial dissolution of marriage. Attempts to liberalize divorce proceedings have also been made earlier. The most common objections to allowing spouses to dissolve their marriage "by mutual consent" out of court include the allegation that such a solution is inconsistent with the Constitution of the Republic of Poland. The article attempts to answer the question whether extrajudicial dissolution of marriage is compatible with the Constitution of the Republic of Poland.
